

## The 59 “One-Anothers” of the New Testament

Be at peace with each other (Mark 9:50; 1 Pt 3:8)

Wash one another's feet (John 13:14)

Love one another (Jhn 13:34-35; 15:12, 17; Rom 13:8; 1 Thess 4:9; 1 Pt 4:8; 1 Jhn 3:11, 3:23, 4:7, 4:11, 4:12; 2 Jhn 5)

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love (Rom 12:10)

Honor one another above yourselves (Rom 12:10)

Live in harmony with one another (Rom 12:16)

Stop passing judgment on one another (Rom 14:13)

Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you (Rom 15:7)

Instruct one another (Rom 15:14; Col 3:16)

Greet one another with a holy kiss (Rom 16:16; 1 Cor 16:20; 2 Cor 13:12; 1 Pt 5:14)

When you come together to eat, wait for each other (1 Cor 11:33)

Have equal concern for each other (1 Cor 12:25)

Serve one another in love (Gal 5:13)

If you keep on biting and devouring each other...you will be destroyed by each other (Gal 5:15)

Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other (Gal 5:26)

Carry each other's burdens (Gal 6:2)

Be patient, bearing with one another in love (Eph 4:2; Col 3:13)

Be kind and compassionate to one another (Eph 4:32)

Forgiving each other (Eph 4:32; Col 3:13)

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs (Eph 5:19)

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ (Eph 5:21)

In humility consider others better than yourselves (Phil 2:3)

Do not lie to each other (Col 3:9)

Make your love increase and overflow for each other (1 Thess 3:12)

Encourage each other (1 Thess 4:18; 5:11; Heb 3:13; Heb 10:25)

Build each other up (1 Thess 5:11)

Spur one another on toward love and good deeds (Heb 10:24)

Do not slander one another (James 4:11)

Don't grumble against each other (James 5:9)

Confess your sins to each other (James 5:16)

Pray for each other (James 5:16)

Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. (1 Pt 4:9)

Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others (1 Pt 4:10)

Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another (1 Pt 5:5)
